STATEMENT OF THE PARTICIPANTS OF THE INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE UNDER THE PROJECT „TOGETHER AGAINST VIOLENCE”

WE, THE PARTICIPANTS IN THE CONFERENCE, HAVE RESOLVED TO UNITE AROUND THE FOLLOWING RECOMMENDATIONS, RELATED TO THE PREVENTION OF THE PERPETRATION OF VIOLENCE BY CHILDREN:

1. THE WORK WITH THE FAMILY AND THE SIGNIFICANT ADULTS IN THE CHILD’S LIFE IS OF KEY IMPORTANCE. THE PROFESSIONALS PRIORITIZE AN ACTIVE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE CHILD AND HIS/HER FAMILY; THEY SUPPORT THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE CAPACITY OF THE PARENTS AND THE SIGNIFICANT ADULTS.
2. THE CARE FOR EACH CHILD IS PLANNED. THE PLANNING NEEDS TO REFLECT THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE CHILD AND THE FAMILY AND TO BE IMPLEMENTED FOR A PARTICULAR PERIOD OF TIME.
3. THE SERVICES WHICH THE CHILDREN PERPETRATORS OF REPEATED VIOLENCE HAVE TO BE VARIED: PRIORITIZING THERAPEUTICALLY SERVICES, IN ORDER TO OVERCOME TRAUMATIC EXPERIENCE; OTHER SERVICES RELATED TO PREVENTION AND INTERVENTION, PROVIDING FOR THE INCREASE OF THE LEVEL OF SOCIAL COMPETENCE AND THE COGNITIVE DEVELOPMENT OF THE CHILD.
4. THE PROCESS OF SUPPORT FOR CHILDREN AND THEIR FAMILIES HAS TO BE ACCOMPANIED AT EVERY STAGE BY CONTROL AND EVALUATION OF ALL THE STAKEHOLDERS: CLIENT, FAMILY, PROFESSIONALS.
5. THE PARTICIPATION OF THE FAMILIES AND THE CHILDREN IN THE PLANNING PROCESS IS REQUIRED. IT IS STIMULATED AND SUPPORTED BY THE PROFESSIONALS.
6. THE SUPPORT IS BASED ON THE NEEDS, RIGHTS, INTERESTS, TALENTS, ABILITIES AND CAPACITY OF THE CHILD. THIS SUPPORT IS INDIVIDUAL AND UNIQUE FOR EACH CHILD.
7. RESIDENTIAL SERVICES: GROUPS, CENTERS, COMMUNITIES, PRESENT POSSIBILITIES FOR A CHANGE IN THE CHILDREN’S BEHAVIOR.



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8. RESIDENTIAL SERVICES HAVE TO PROVIDE DEVELOPMENT OF POSITIVE BEHAVIORAL MODELS FOR THE CHILDREN AND THEIR FAMILIES, AS WELL AS PSYCHOLOGICAL SUPPORT AND SUPPORT FOR BETTER INTEGRATION.
9. THE INTENSIVENESS OF THE PROCESS OF SUPPORT IS OF KEY IMPORTANCE. THE PROCESS IS BASED ON CONFIDENTIAL PARTNERSHIP BETWEEN THE CLIENT, THE FAMILY AND THE PROFESSIONALS.
10. THE PROFESSIONALS, WORKING WITH CHILDREN PERPETRATORS OF REPEATED VIOLENCE, RECEIVE TRAINING AND ARE WELL PREPARED FOR THE FUNCTIONS THEY EXERCISE.
11. IT IS OF KEY IMPORTANCE THAT THEY HAVE RECEIVED ADDITIONAL TRAINING FOR UTILIZATION OF SPECIFIC METHODS AND TECHNIQUES FOR SUPPORT OF CHANGE IN BEHAVIOR.
12. PROFESSIONALS ARE PROVIDED WITH SUPPORT THROUGH INTERVISION, SUPERVISION, AND PERIODIC EVALUATION.
13. THE LEGISLATION AND THE SERVICES FOR CHILDREN PERPETRATORS OF REPEATED VIOLENCE HAVE TO BE DIRECTED AT ACHIEVING GOOD PROSPECTS FOR THE CHILDREN AND THEIR FAMILIES.
