“Malort” is a project for children starting from the age of four years, young people and adults, which helps to focus and relax as well as it promotes social competence.

Since Mai 2012 painting lessons are offered to the visitors of the youth centre. The centre has an open structure; children and youth can decide freely every week if they want to attend the lessons. The “place to paint” is also attended regularly by groups of children who are in day care. They meet regularly once a week for 30 to 60 minutes in order to paint. This concept was developed by Arno Stern in an orphanage in Paris (1950).

### *Angekommen*

Guido Markowitz developed this play together with 7 young people living in the residential group „Kassiopeia“ and 9 young persons living in Bochum and its surroundings. It focuses on the moment of decision: who decides if a young person is allowed to arrive? What do we need in order to really arrive and settle in this country, in our lives and to shape our future? Or does our life remain a long journey? Will I ever find a place for myself? All adolescents think about these questions but refugees do have a special focus on it. The group approaches these central issues about becoming an adult from different angles.
