#### Our Story






- Established in Kisumu in 1993
- Began as a rescue center for street boys, providing long-term care for these children 2008: Implemented concept of placing former street children back with families
- 2009: Began assisting Children's Remand Home in Kisumu with placement of children back in their homes.
- 2011: 208 former street children were living successfully at home with their families.
- 2012: Opened a Girls Center in Kisumu
- Today: 78 Kenyan staff members employed
- Today: Over 1,700 street and other at-risk children have been successfully reintegrated with families






Kisumu Quarterly Street Census - People on Streets Children's Ministry




#### Children Rescued by Month in 2016


Estimated Impact of Street Rescue in 2016\*

Boys Rehabilitated by Source in 2016






Girls Rehabilitated by Source in 2016




Children Rehabilitated by Source in 2016





#### **Child Status Index**


- Objective measurement tool
- Determines suitability of a home targeted for child placement
- Provides ability to assess improvement or degradation of a home situation over time
- Facilitates program planning for family empowerment






Number of Children Active in Program













Reintegrated Children Nationwide by County











Reintegration Success Rates by Year Group








